The theory may doubtless be rigorously extended to this case by considerations, familiar and simple enough to those who are acquainted with the general theory of limits and the idea of continuity as employed in the higher branches of mathematics, but difficult for the less advanced student to grasp and keep a clear hold of. For these reasons it seems desirable that an independent and rigorous theory for magnitudes generally, without distinction of commensurable and incommensurable, should form part of the course of Elementary Geometry....
